From The Desks of Pastors Craig McCune & Mark Bintliff:

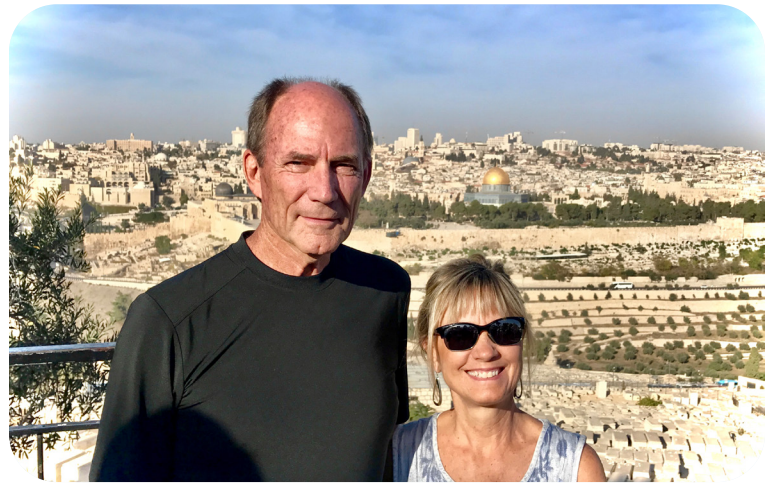

ITINERARY

Sunday, October 25, 2020

Depart USA for Tel Aviv, Israel

Monday, October 26, 2020

Arrive Ben Gurion Airport. Meeting and assistance after passport control. Once everyone has their luggage you will be escorted to the arrival hall where your guide and driver await you. Drive to Tel Aviv and time permitting before checking into your hotel visit Old Jaffa. Check into your hotel. Dinner and overnight.

Overnight: Tel Aviv, Israel

Tuesday, October 27, 2020

Breakfast at your hotel. This morning (if we did not visit Jaffa yesterday) we will begin our tour with a walk through the narrow passages of Old Jaffa, believed to be the oldest port city in the world and where cedars from Lebanon arrived to build Solomon's Temple see St. Peter's Church and take a spectacular view of Tel Aviv Shoreline from Jaffa Hilltop. Peter came to Jaffa (Joppa) from Lydda to raise Tabitha (Dorcas) from the dead While in Jaffa, the apostle stayed at the house of Simon the Tanner. St. Peter's Church marks the traditional site of Peter's vision of the Great Sheet. Depart Tel Aviv driving north along the coastal plain to Caesarea, which was the center of early Christians, and capital of Judea under the Romans. Visit the excavations of this ancient city, the Roman theatre and aqueduct, here where Paul made his defense before Festus and King Agrippa prior to his final journey to Rome. Our next stop is Mount Carmel (Muchraka), where Elijah issued his challenge



to the False Prophets. Continue to Megiddo, identified as the site of Armageddon, see the remains from Solomon's days, view the site where the Battle of Armageddon will be fought. Visit the archaeological excavations at Megiddo, including the well preserved water supply system. We make our way now to the beautiful Sea of Galilee and our home for the next three nights. Dinner and overnight.

Wednesday, October 28, 2020

After breakfast we will make our way to the dock where our wooden boat awaits us to sail on the Sea of Galilee and bring us to Ginosar. Here we will be visiting the "Ancient Jesus Boat" the remains of a 2,000 year old fishing boat that would have been the type used by Jesus' apostles, We will now make our way to visit the Mount of Beatitudes where Jesus preached the Sermon on the Mount. We will make our way to Capernaum the center of Jesus' Galilean ministry and the site of many of His miracles. You will see the remains of Peter's house and the synagogue site where Jesus taught and worshiped. Stop for lunch a lakeside restaurant where we will feast on the famous St. Peter's Fish. Drive to Tabgha, where in all four Gospels it is said that it was that Jesus was able to feed 5000 men with only five loaves of bread and two fish. We make our way now to visit the latest excavations in Midgal, ancient Magdala and the home of Mary Magdalene. This is truly the crossroad of Jewish and Christian History. Our last stop of the day will be the Yardenit where anyone wishing to be baptized may do so. From here we return to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

Thursday, October 29, 2020

After breakfast we will drive to Mt of Beatitude where Jesus gave his Sermon on the Mount. Next we will drive to the northern border Kibbutzim, MisGav Am. Here we will meet with the civilian liaison who will give us an up close look at the situation with Hezbollah in Lebanon. Continue to towards the the Golan Heights and stop to visit Banias, one of the sources of the River Jordan and the site of ancient Caesarea Philippi, where Peter made his confession of faith in Christ (Matt. 16:16). Drive to Har Ben Tal which is a dormant volcano in the North-Eastern part of the Golan Heights, The view of Mt. Hermon and the Golan Heights is not only breathtaking but gives you the insight into the importance of the area to Israel and Leor our guide will tell us the story of the "Valley of the Tears", which is the long stretch of valley in between Mount Bental and Mount Hermon and how it got its name. 100 Israeli tanks were reduced to seven under extreme enemy fire but still came out the superior force. As we begin a tour back to the Sea of Galilee, we will stop in Bethsaida (The House of the Fisherman) Jesus was both active as a preacher and also a healer. In Matthew & Luke it is written that this is the location where Jesus healed the blind man. Our next stop will be on the eastern shore of the Sea of Galilee to visit Kursi and see the 6th century Byzantine basilica that marks the site where Jesus healed two men possessed by demons.

Return to your hotel for dinner and overnight.

Friday, October 30, 2020

After breakfast we will leave the Sea of Galilee and drive to Beit-Shean/Scythopolis, the most magnificent archeological site in Israel, located at the strategic juncture of the Jezreel and Jordan valleys. Like Jericho, it has been almost continuously occupied throughout history. After defeating Saul and his sons on Mt. Gilboa, the Philistines hanged their bodies on the walls of Beit-Shean. During the time of Jesus, Scythopolis was one of the chief cities of the Decapolis - a league of ten cities sharing Greek culture and government. Following the fertile Jordan Valley southward, your guide will point out the agricultural restoration of the "Land of Milk and Honey" and Israel's intricate irrigation development. We pass ancient Jericho and view from a distance this city famed as the oldest in the world. To the east of Jericho along the Jordan River Valley (Queser El Yehud) is the Israeli side of Bethany Beyond the Jordan. In this area Jesus was baptized by John the Baptist, Elijah and Elisha crossed the Jordan, as well as where the children of Israel, led by Joshua, entered the Promised Land. Drive up to Mt Scopus for your first view of the "Golden City" of Jerusalem, before making your way to the Western Wall where the locals and tourists alike Welcome the Shabbat. Continue to your hotel. Dinner and overnight.

Saturday, October 31, 2020

After breakfast at our hotel. An interesting and educational time awaits us at the Israel Museum. Walk through collections of centuries-old Israeli artifacts including the Dead Sea Scrolls, and then a guided tour of an accurately detailed model of Biblical Jerusalem will help to prepare you for what you will experience in the following days. Drive to the Mount of Olives for an awesome panoramic view of the Old City of Jerusalem and the Golden Gates of the Old City. We will drive or stroll down to the bottom of the mountain to the Garden of Gethsemane, where Jesus prayed in many occasions and where Jesus was arrested. Drive to the Church of St. Peter In Gallicantu which commemorates Peter's triple denial of Christ and cock crowing twice. Make your way to Mt Zion to the Room of the Last Supper and King David's Tomb before driving to Bethlehem and visit Shepherd's field & see the Church of the Nativity built over the cave where generations believe Jesus was born! Stop to visit a local shop owned by one of the Christian families still in Bethlehem. Return to your hotel for dinner and overnight.

Sunday, November 01, 2020

After an early breakfast, we will drive towards the Dead Sea area. Our route will take us back down the main highway towards Jericho. As we get closer to the shores of the Dead Sea, we will start to descend to the lowest point on the surface of the earth at 1305 feet (398m) below sea level. We will drive along the shores south and stop at Qumran,



where a young shepherd boy discovered the Dead Sea Scrolls and drive to Masada. We will continue south to the legendary mountaintop plateau of Masada and ascend by cable car to the ancient synagogue and to explore the ancient fortress. Here, was the last stronghold of the Jewish Zealots in their struggle against the Romans. The Zealots held out for three years against the legions of Flavius Silva and chose to die as free men at their own hands in preference to Roman slavery. From the top of Masada, the outlines of the Roman encampments are still visible below. We will stop at a Dead Sea facility for a short time at leisure. Here we will have the opportunity to float atop the unsinkable Dead Sea. Return to Jerusalem for dinner & overnight.

Monday, November 02, 2020

Breakfast at your hotel. Conditions permitting we will visit the Temple Mount, with commentary on the Temple Periods, and the variety of belief systems past and present that make this area so valuable. Making our way to the St Stephen Gate, we will stop at the Church of St. Anne for a worship service (pending confirmation with the church) We meet our motor coach awaits us and we will drive around the walls to the City of David. From the City of David visitor center we will begin our journey through Warren's Shaft and Hezekiah's Tunnel to the Pools of Silwan. From here we will walk through to the new Herodian Tunnel that will bring us up to Robinson's Arch on the southern side of The Temple was the main entrance for the common folk, whereas the Priests and Levites had their own entrance from the higher eastern side. Parts of the giant stairs, which led to the Temple Mount from the courtyard have been unearthed along with the purification pools. From here Jesus entered the Temple Mount and drove out the vendors and money changers who were exploiting the people. It is also likely that this is the place that Peter stood and preached and where thousands were saved and baptized on the Day of Pentecost. Return to your hotel for dinner and then return to the Old City this evening for a special night tour of the Western Wall and then the fascinating Rabbinical Tunnels leading us through the Second Temple era. The tunnel and exhibit give a clear understanding of the amazing construction of the Temple Mount, giant

stones, water supply and Roman street where our Lord was led to judgment. Before exiting the tunnel we see the immense cornerstone rejected by the builders. Return to your hotel for overnight.

Tuesday, November 03, 2020

Breakfast at your hotel. We will begin our day with a visit to Yad Vashem the Memorial to the Six Million Jews that perished during the Holocaust. Next we will visit the Friends of Zion Heritage Center which is dedicated to the world wide Christian Community which helped the Jewish people throughout the ages. We close out our organized touring with a visit and communion at the Garden Tomb. This afternoon we have left time for people to return to the Old City if they wish before returning to the hotel and preparing for our departure. Tour and Communion. Pack up our luggage and make our way for our final dinner at the hotel. Transfer to the airport for your return flight home* Depending upon airline it might be early Wednesday morning departure
